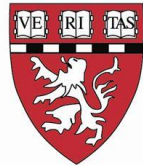

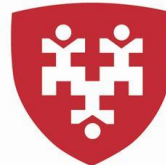

Priority 1: Regulatory system

- Mobilize resources to strengthening ward inspection system as part of decentralized inspection system
- Explore how to incorporate association self-regulation-proposed system for reporting malpractice and violation of ADDO regulations. Associations have the potential to self-regulate using their own resources.

Priority 2: Addressing AMR

- MOHSW/Pharmaceutical Sector Support (PSS), TFDA, and PC should address AMR and medicines use among health facility workers, dispensers in drug outlets, and community members comprehensively

Tasked to Pharmacy Council & PSS Pharmaceutical working group



Priority 3: On going monitoring of services provided by ADDOs

- To be able to incorporate research method and data into routine monitoring:
 - Limited data should be collected at a defined point of time (indicators can vary over time)
 - Data collection should be incorporated into routine activities
 - Mobile technology should be used
 - Linkage between regulatory authority and research/training institutions to generate research data for use with regulatory authorities

Priority 4: ADDO medicine list

- Review of ADDO medicine list should consider:
 - Burden of chronic diseases at the community
 - Results of product quality testing done by TFDA and other partners
 - Alternative products to those that are temperature and light sensitive (requiring no cold chain)

Priority 5: Dispenser training

- Prerequisites for admittance into the ADDO dispenser training course may need to be revised due to the depletion of those with nursing assistant qualification.

Priority 6: Technology integration (database, GIS, mobile)

- Scale up the technology integrations components- the integration of database, mobile reporting and electronic inspection tools to enhance PC regulatory processes and ultimately improve services.

Priority 7: Referral

- Address barriers on ADDO referrals to health facilities
 - Sensitization of CHMT, public health facilities providers
 - Directive from MOHSW, PC, RHMT/CHMT?
